IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION

This show is sanctioned by USEF as a Lite show. Anyone who signs the entry blank as a trainer must have a current USEF competing membership and be Safe Sport trained before the show. This applies to all adults aged 18 years or older.

Every entry blank must be signed on the trainer line. Therefore, if you are an owner or amateur who is showing without a trainer, or sign as a parent of a youth who is showing without a trainer, you must also sign on the trainer line and therefore you will be required to have a USEF competing membership and be Safe Sport trained before the show. Please visit www.usef.org to join or renew your membership and complete the Safe Sport training before arriving at the show.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. General Rules/Regulations

Admission of Horses: Stalls will not be available until 2pm on Wednesday July 23rd. Horses should leave the show grounds by no later than 11pm on Sunday July 27th. If you need to show up before 2pm on Wednesday, please contact the barn manager prior to the show for authorization. **Any horses on the grounds before 2pm on Wednesday without prior authorization will have an extra \$10 fee added to their show bills for each horse.**

Americans with Disabilities Act: It is important to Georgia PFHA that everyone involved in our shows and events has the best experience possible. If you have any needs or ADA accessibility issues which we could address in advance to make your experience better, please contact the show chairman.

Arena/Work Hours: The practice arena will be open starting **Thursday July 24th at 8am until 10 pm** for working horses. Main arena will be announced on **Thursday**. A 30 minute warning will be given and the 10 pm deadline will be strictly upheld no matter what. The main arena will be open on **Friday July 25th before the show starts at 7am going until 12pm** with the show starting at 2pm. The warm up arena will be open the whole time for anyone wishing to work horses. **Arena lights will be turned off at 10pm each night. Barn lights will be turned off at 11pm each night.**

Changes/Cancellations: Management reserves the right to combine, cancel, or run concurrently any class or classes as needed for the show, or to reschedule classes after notification to exhibitors. Management also reserves the right to change or alter the officials listed without notice prior to or during the show. Management is not responsible for cancellations due to severe weather or other emergencies.

Class Calls/Check in: Class calls are not mandatory, they are a courtesy. It is your job as exhibitors to keep track of the class schedule and where we are in it to get ready for your class. You must check in with the paddock keeper and they must verify your back number. Just because you are in the warm up arena/check in area does not mean you are actually checked in.

Coggins/Health Papers: In accordance to Georgia state law, all horses on the show grounds must have a current negative Coggins certificate. A copy will also need to be provided to the office as well. This goes for competing and non-competing horses- no exceptions. For all out of state horses, a health certificate dated within the last 30 days before the show must also be provided to the office and be readily available if asked by any member of show management or facility management.

Discourtesy: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom, may disqualify the horse and cause the owner to forfeit his/her entry fee and other fees and be removed from the grounds. This show and the Georgia PFHA Board of Directors and show management do support and will enforce all PFHA and USEF rules regarding sportsmanship, conduct, and courtesy at all PFHA recognized shows or events. Any violations committed will be subject to appropriate PFHA and USEF penalties.

Dogs on Show Grounds: All pets must be leashed or otherwise contained while on the show grounds. Any unruly pets that cause issues for any of our exhibitors or horses may be asked to leave the show grounds.

Drug Testing: Because this is a USEF Lite show, any competing horses are subject to random drug testing through USEF. However, exhibitors do not have to pay the drug fee associated with this.

Emergency Care: There will be an EMT on the show grounds during show hours on Friday and Saturday.

Entries: All entries must be received by July 16th to avoid the Post-entry fees. All paperwork must be completed and sent to the show secretary. Please see page 2 for a full list of forms required for entry along with a fee list. A check maybe be substituted for the CC authorization form at the show as long as one has been submitted with the entries.

Exhibitor Dinner and “Not-so-Silent” Auction: Our Exhibitor Dinner will be a potluck style dinner where exhibitors can bring any dish they would like.

Farrier: The on call farrier will be posted on the show grounds.

Medical Professional: During the show, we will have a licensed medical professional on the grounds at all times.

Motorized Vehicle Statement: Only persons with a valid driver's license from their state of residence will be permitted to operate any motorized vehicle, including but not limited to golf carts, mopeds, scooters, or farm utility vehicles while on the show grounds. Sanctions and penalties may be imposed upon the parent, guardian, or trainer of any minors who violate this policy.

Non-Showing Horses: All non-showing horses on the show grounds must comply with the same rules and health requirements as competing horses. An entry form must be on file with the show office for all non-competing horses and must be on a stall request form as well.

Parking: All trailers must be parked in the designated parking area. There are 2 parking lots for regular vehicles on the show grounds- one closest to the main arena and one closest to the RV hookups. At all times, an emergency lane around the barn must be readily available for all emergency services. Any vehicle blocking said lane may be towed at the owner's expense.

Questions: Any and all questions not covered in the prize list may be directed to show management and their decision will be final.

Refunds: Refunds will be based on individual situations and discussed by show management, whose decision is final.

Returned Checks or Declined Credit Cards: All checks returned for non-payment, or credit cards that are declined, will be charged a handling fee of \$50 and must be replaced by cash, certified check, or cashier's check within 2 weeks of notification.

Shavings: All stalls include 3 bags of shavings however extra shavings can be purchased through management. **No outside shavings are allowed on the show grounds.**

Show Office: On Friday, it will be open starting at 8am and remain open until the last class. On Saturday, it will open starting at 8am until the last class of the day. **You must check out with the show secretary before leaving the show grounds on Saturday night.** You may add or switch classes up to 10 classes ahead of the class you are adding or deleting. This does not include championship classes.

Veterinarian: The on call vet will be posted on the show grounds.

Youth Stalls: Enter a youth horse before the pre-entry deadline to receive a half price stall! If a horse is being shown by a youth rider at the show, that horse will receive a stall for \$60. It MUST be entered by the pre-entry deadline for the rate to apply. If the horse is no longer being shown by a youth but still being shown, the pricing WILL BE FULL PRICE on the stall.

Federation Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Federation Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification. This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I have read the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") Entry Agreement (GR906.4) as printed in the Prize List for this Competition and agree to all of its provisions. I understand and agree that by entering this Competition, I am subject to Federation Rules, the Prize List, and local rules of the competition. I agree to waive the right to the use of my photos at the competition, and agree that any actions against the Federation must be brought in New York State.

I **AGREE** in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I **AGREE** that the "Federation" and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I **AGREE** that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulteur, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I **AGREE** to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I **AGREE** to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I **AGREE** to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and, if applicable, EV114 and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

WARNING:

Under Georgia law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 12 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

By signing below, that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time, as well as all terms and provisions of this Prize List. If, despite this Agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf or the minor's behalf, makes a claim for Liability against any of the Released Parties, I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any such Liabilities as the result of such claim.

The parties agree that this agreement may be electronically signed. The parties agree that the electronic signatures appearing on this agreement are the same as handwritten signatures for the purposes of validity, enforceability, and admissibility.

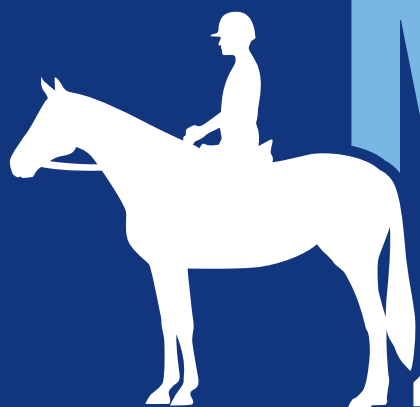
